Sams Kids Club

- Regular teaching about God at after school clubs in Seaton and Cornhill
- Visiting children in homes to develop relationships with families
- Holiday clubs which provide for children during the holidays and give a more extended time when they can learn more about God.
- Volunteers who model the love of God and act as positive role models in the children's lives
- SU group for teenagers in St Machar to help them move on in faith
- Encouraging the kids to engage with God personally through prayer
- Junior leaders system giving more responsibility to P7s and helping them to stay engaged.



Lighthouse

- Drop in groups for men and women on a Mon/Wed which serve as a first point of contact for many in the community
- Giving soup, rolls and food parcels to demonstrate God's love practically
- 'Transform' group on a Tuesday to encourage women to make progress in life
- 1-1 meetings with volunteers to help people individually
- Discipleship courses on a Thursday
- TnT meetings where people hear the gospel and are able to take part in worship
- Work with children and families, seeking to bring God's wisdom and love into situations
